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POSITION DESCRIPTION: Head Coach of Basketball

Purpose Statement

To faithfully serve and support all students, parents and staff of the Christian College community. This is to be achieved through the positive use of skills and talents to achieve the administrative outcomes required and expected by the Christian College community. This act of service is a reflection of the servant nature of Jesus as it is observed in his compassion and care of all people.

Expectations of Duties

- be dressed neatly when coaching in the provided Eagles Polo Top
- ensure compliance of the CC Eagles Basketball Club Philosophy
- instruct a team/group of students in a sport/activity as is required
- officiate a sport, using rules and expectations as is set down by the sport's governing body
- if instructing, the instruction must be planned, sequential and delivered in a manner that ensures the students are safe, engaged and active
- if officiating, check the playing area for obstacles and dangers to ensure that players are safe. Officiate with authority and ensure dangerous play is acted upon quickly
- in preparation for sessions arrive at least 15 minutes prior to commencement to set up/pack equipment
- at the conclusion of the sessions ensure that all equipment used is packed away and assist other, coaches and assistants with packing away equipment
- complete administrative duties as is required by the Head Basketball Coach

Behaviours

The behaviours required of you whenever you are on duty representing Christian College whether on or off campus can best be summarised as *“treating others as you would like them to treat you”*.

Examples of this behavioural philosophy include, but are not limited to:

- act with integrity at all times
- be open and honest in all communication – students, staff and parents
- respond promptly to communications
- show respect to all students, staff and parents
- must maintain appropriate relationships with students at all times
- embrace change
- act with professionalism ensuring ***that personal goals are in line with the College vision and strategies***
- have a good working knowledge of all the policies and procedures
- be a self-starter, show initiative
- strive for excellence, take pride in what you do
- be accountable and responsible
- be punctual
- offer ideas for improvement
- offer and receive feedback
- be active in managing hazards and risks associated in performing daily tasks

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ROLE DESCRIPTION: Head Coach of Basketball

Christian College Geelong is seeking to appoint a Head Coach of Basketball to lead our extensive basketball program across all four campuses.

The College has wonderful facilities with 2 indoor stadiums at the Highton and Bellarine campuses and an indoor facility at the Belmont and Waurn Ponds campuses. There are over 350 players representing the Eagles Basketball Club and 200 players who represent the College in a number of basketball competitions each year.

The College is willing to consider all options for this role. Possible options could be:

- a) Full-time – Head Coach of Basketball (0.6) and Teacher (0.4)
- b) Full-time – Head Coach of Basketball (0.6) and another non-teaching role (0.4)
- c) Part-time – Head Coach of Basketball (up to 30 hours a week)
- d) Other options will be reviewed if they fully address coverage of our expectations for the role.

The role of the Head Coach of Basketball contains two separate components. Head Coach of the Christian College Eagles Basketball Club and Coach of the Christian College Geelong school teams. These components may be shared by two employees.

The Head Coach of the Eagles Basketball Club reports to the Club President and works with the Club Administrator.

Head Coach of Christian College Eagles Basketball Club duties Include;

1. Promote the sport

- To the Christian College Student, Staff and Parent body
- To the wider Geelong and Bellarine communities

2. Increase Participation

- Conduct introductory programs (eg. Fledgling Eagles) at the junior levels of the College
- Liaise with Campus Sports Coordinator's to identify potential players
- Identify and appoint potential coaches for teams

3. Foster Pathways

- With local associations, state & national body
- Promote and link players and coaches with programs run by these bodies

4. Provide coaching/expertise

- To players at club practice session and games
- To coaches at club practice sessions and games
- Uphold & develop Club Philosophy
- Organise and select teams for each season
- Develop coaches and coaching techniques within the club

The Coach of Christian College Geelong School teams reports to the Christian College Director of Sport and works with the Sports Administrator.

Coach of Christian College Geelong school teams duties include;

- Working with the Director of Sport to identify the events & tournaments the school will enter teams in.
- Liaise with Campus Sport Coordinator to arrange selection trials and training programs to prepare teams for competition.
- Working with Campus Sport Coordinator to deliver basketball specific or general ball handling skills to students in the junior years within the College Sport and Physical Education programs.
- Preparation of reports; Calendar Plans, Review of teams and School Communication
- Where required provide individual tuition to selected students within the College.
- As required coach other sports within the College Sport program.
