WOODWIND TEACHING VACANCY

Due to an increase in enrolments, a vacancy has arisen at Christian College Geelong – Highton Campus, for a woodwind teacher to join our Instrumental Music team for Term 3, 2018. The successful candidate should have the ability to teach clarinet and saxophone from beginner to advanced level. This role is currently for approximately half a day per week (3.5 hours), with the potential to grow in the future.

Christian College Geelong has a dynamic music education program, delivered by a team of highly dedicated, skilled and experienced teaching staff. There are currently 800 students learning instruments across five campuses and an extensive ensemble program featuring Choirs, String Orchestras and Bands.

The Position

Teaching Clarinet and Saxophone to students Year 5-12, from beginner to advanced, including high-level AMEB/VCE students.
