Small and medium sized boxes, matchboxes, icy pole sticks, cardboard rolls, foil, drinking straws, small stones/ rocks, off cuts of wood, paper plates, plastic/ paper cups, plastic bottles, wool, string, pegs, material scraps, bottle corks, milk cartons, packing foam, shredded paper, buttons, foil pie plates, meat trays, disposable food containers, bottle lids, cotton reels, old toy cars etc...
